**Welcome to the New Beginnings Consecration week!** Thank you for making a commitment to hearing God in the coming week. We are moving forward together as a church family towards, healing, health, and wholeness.

Decide (if you have not already done so) on the times that you will pray daily. Set an alarm if you need to. Put together your worship music list play it as often as you can to help keep you focused.

The goal is to establish an intimate relationship with God. As you pray, spend time listening for God to respond back to you. We have included some themes to direct your prayers Please don't view these prayers as an exercise where you just pray the prayers on the calendar and then go about your day. Have a conversation with God. If you spend intentional time reading the Bible and in prayer then expect God to speak to you throughout the day. This may be as you read through his word and or in your thoughts.

Choose to fast at least one day this week. If you can fast more will fast from social media, the internet, and/or food or a combination of some or all to focus on prayer. This is an individual choice so please ask God for direction in determining what you should fast from. Families are encouraged to fast together to create greater unity within their respective household. Please seek medical advice before participating.

Here is a guide to for starting your fast;

*With God's help I commit to fasting \_\_\_\_\_ day(s) of the week from the hours of \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_. I will sacrifice \_\_\_\_\_ (a meal, social media, etc.). During this time of fasting, I am asking God to (list petitions and scripture that supports the petition. For example, Heal my body in accordance with Isaiah 53:4-5; Psalm 107:19-20. Make sure that you not only write down the Scripture but confess it throughout the time of your fasting and claim God's promise.*

**Identify and Pray for Your Sphere of Influence:** Each of us has people in our lives that God has called us to influence. The obvious are our friends and family members but don't forget about your co-workers, people you may meet during the course of your day including grocery store clerks, fast food servers, doctors, people in the checkout line, etc. who may need your prayers. Sometimes you can ask them if you can pray for them but many times you can just pray to God on their behalf.

**Participate in Corporate Prayer:** Join us for one of the sessions of corporate prayer either in person or via Zoom.

**Perform an Act of Kindness:** Perform at least one act of kindness this week. Ask God to make you a blessing to someone. We are moving away from self-centeredness where we go through our day consumed with our own needs and ask God to show us people who He can reach through us. You are an agent of blessing who is contagiously blessed!

**Go on Prayer Walks:** Release the blessing of the Lord on your neighbors as you walk through your neighborhood. No, we are not challenging the demonic powers in the area but simply inviting God to come into those areas where we find ourselves throughout the day. Ask God to come into your neighborhood. Ask Him to protect the homes and the residents. As you walk by a home, ask God to save the people in that house, and to meet their needs.

**Pray for Household Salvation:** Ask God to bring everyone in your household into the Kingdom of God. Write down all of the individuals you are asking God to save during this time of consecration. Pray the designated salvation prayer daily. Your prayers are a powerful force that should be specifically targeted to bringing deliverance. Please don't pray about their faults and their sins, instead focus on going after the strongman that is preventing them from seeing the truth of the Gospel. (Mark 3:27) Let the Holy Spirit do His job.

### **Prayer for Household**

Father, I come before you in the name of Jesus, confessing Your word that says You desire everyone to be saved and to come into the knowledge of the truth, so I bring \_\_\_\_\_ before you this day. I stand in my authority and I break the power of Satan and those in his kingdom and bind any of their activities and curses from \_\_\_\_\_'s life. I release the power of the Holy Spirit to override all of Satan's activities, curses, plans, and purposes for their lives. I ask you to deliver them from every addiction, lie, snare, spirit, trap, or device Satan is using to hold them in bondage and ask you to remove every agent of Satan from \_\_\_\_\_'s life. I pray for you to send your assigned laborer(s) equipped with the ability to minister to them in a way that will open his/her eyes to see the truth of the Gospel and receive it. We claim the backslider confessing that the good work you began in them will be brought to completion until the day of Jesus Christ. I praise You in advance for bringing \_\_\_\_\_ into the Kingdom.

## **Sunday**

The act of consecration is the fresh act of dedicating yourself— and or your home, a relationship, a job, whatever needs God's grace—deliberately and intentionally to Jesus, bringing it fully into his kingdom and under his rule. It seems so obvious, now that we state it, but you would be surprised how often this vital step is overlooked (and then folks wonder why their prayers don't seem to be effective). It is a time of giving God more attention.

Over the next few days, you will find several different prayers of consecration. You may want or need to change some ideas or wording to fit the specific aspects you want to consecrate. These are just guides use them as you need them.

## **Monday January 11**

**Read:** Romans 12; Joshua 3

### **Pray**

1) Adore - Confess - Thanksgiving - Supplication

2) I present my body to Jesus Christ as a living sacrifice; I present the members of my body to Jesus Christ as instruments of righteousness. **Read:** Exodus 15:22

**Pray:**

Pray for healing of your body and mind physical and emotional.

Father, You are the Healer of the brokenhearted. You declare that You bind up their wounds. Because it is Your nature to heal, I ask You to heal me of all my emotional wounds. Set me free from any unforgiveness; deliver me from harboring unforgiveness. Remove any anger and hatred from my life; replace it with love. Remove any depression and despair from my life; replace it with joy. Remove any fear and anxiety from me and replace it with peace. Remove any resentment and temper and replace it with longsuffering. Remove bitterness and a critical spirit and replace it with kindness. Remove selfishness and replace it with goodness. Fill me with Your love; manifest Your power and grace by healing and blessing in the name of your son Jesus.

## Thursday, January 14

**Read:** Matthew 5:21 -25

**Pray:**

- 1) Pray for forgiveness and reconciliation (where possible) with your family members.
- 2) Pray for the people in your home. Ask God to bring everyone in your household into the Kingdom of God. Use this prayer as a guide.

Father, thank you for the blessing and the provision of this home. We bring it under our authority now, and under the authority of Jesus Christ. We take full authority over this home, in the name of Jesus Christ. The keys to this home have been given to us—authority has been given to us— and we take total and complete authority over this entire home now, in Jesus' name. We renounce all ungodliness and all sinful activity that has ever taken place in this home. We renounce the sins of all previous owners, renters, guests, even the builder (for those are the things that give the enemy claim). We cancel every claim the enemy can make here, by the blood of Jesus Christ. We cleanse this home with the blood of Christ—everything spiritual, everything physical. We consecrate and we dedicate this home to the rule of Jesus Christ, and to the Holy Spirit. We consecrate the appliances, the structure, and infrastructure, the water and electricity; we consecrate the physical realm and the spiritual realm; we consecrate the land as well. [Walk through every room, do this very deliberately.] Come, Holy Spirit, come and fill every part of this home with the glory of your kingdom, with love, with peace, with holy rest. Jesus, we ask your angels to cleanse this home now, to establish your kingdom here, to build a shield of protection around it. In the mighty name of Jesus Christ the Lord, we now proclaim this home and land and everything in it the property of the kingdom of God.
